UCFS awarded \$1M in federal funds for community health center services

NORWICH - United Community and Family Services on Tuesday was awarded a multi-year federal grant that will augment programs and care it offers through its five community health centers, officials announced.

The \$1.19 million grant from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' Health Resources and Services Administration will provide a variety of services to UCFS clients. The Norwich-based nonprofit was recently identified by federal officials as a new access point, opening it up for the funding.

"This has been a long time coming. The New Access Point brings additional resources that northern New London County and the communities we serve need and deserve," UCFS President and CEO Chuck Seeman said in a statement provided by U.S. Rep. Joe Courtney, D-2nd District.
