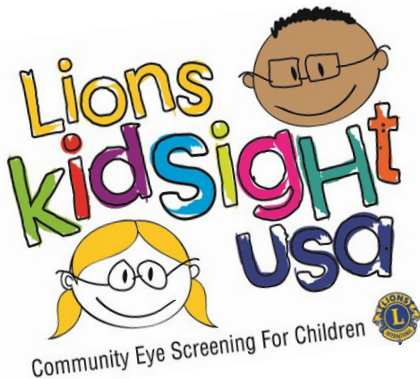




FREE Pediatric Vision Screenings and Amber Alert Registration Monday, August 10, 2015

The Lions pediatric eye screening program has helped prevent serious eye problems for thousands of children worldwide. The vision test uses medically approved equipment and takes only about two minutes per child. The screening uses PediaVision SPOT VS100 which takes a detailed picture of the child's eyes. The camera prints out an analysis, which can then be presented to the child's eye doctor if a problem is detected. Parent/Guardian must be present for the screening.

The Rotary Club of Norwich Alert Child ID program is available for all children under the age of 18. The parent/guardian needs to be present to sign a consent. They will receive a wallet-sized laminated card with a photo of the child, a unique AMBER ID number and only minimal, yet essential, information needed to find a child in the event the child is abducted. The encrypted information is sent to a secured National AMBER Alert database.
