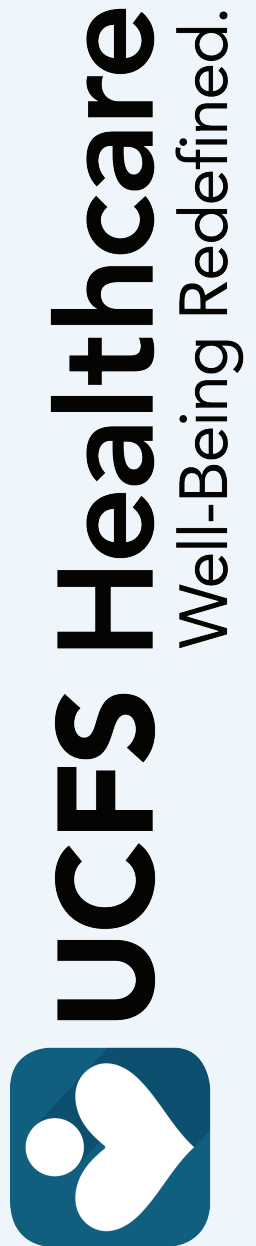

Programs & Services

PRIMARY AND SPECIALTY MEDICAL SERVICES

Adult and Pediatric Primary Care

Board certified Internists, Pediatricians & Family Practice Physicians and Nurse Practitioners provide comprehensive medical services with evening hours and 24 hour on-call. The adult physicians actively collaborate with the hospitalists for inpatient care.

Gynecology

Geriatric Assessment & Management Program

Evaluates the whole person, not just the disease(s) he/she may possess. Provides memory testing, counseling for the patient and family referrals as necessary. The physician works collaboratively with the patient's primary care physician. The goal of the program is to promote, restore and maintain functional independence.

ELDERCARE SERVICES

Sheltering Arms

A residential care home for men and women 60 years of age and older. Residents receive help with personal care and medication administration from a nurse or round-the-clock resident attendants. The monthly fee covers a private room, all meals, personal laundry, housekeeping services and recreational activities.

Medical model adult day program that provides meals, therapeutic recreation, daily living skills assistance, personal care, social supports, nursing services, medication management, rehabilitative therapy, podiatry, exercise programs and beautician services.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH SERVICES

Access to Care Program

Screens uninsured clients to determine their eligibility for insurance programs such as HUSKY, Medicaid, Access Health CT and others. Clients who may be eligible are assisted in the application process.

The Eastern Connecticut Medical Home Initiative

Provides care coordination services to children and youth with special health care needs and their families/caregivers. Care Coordinators work with children's health care providers to link children and families to medical, educational and other community-based services.

Case Management

Provides support and coordination of services to clients struggling with basic needs such as stable housing, food, health insurance, employment and training or barriers accessing health care services.

Mobile Crisis Intervention Services

Provides services for children and adolescents who are experiencing a psychiatric or behavioral health crisis.

Intensive Family Preservation

Provides in-home risk reduction and stabilization services for families referred by the Department of Children and Families.

Multidimensional Family Therapy

Provides intensive in-home individual and family therapy and case management services for youth and adolescents ages 9-18 years who are using substances or at risk thereof.

Early Childhood Consultation Partnership

Provides mental health consultation designed to meet the social and emotional needs of children birth to five by offering support, education and consultation to caregivers, early childhood centers and families.

Child First

Intensive in-home clinical services for infants and children through age five who are experiencing social, emotional and behavioral health difficulties and their families, utilizing a professional team of a Master's level Developmental Clinician and a Care Coordinator. Child First's two-generation approach builds strong, nurturing, caregiver-child relationships, promotes adult capacity and connects families with needed services.

Care Coordination

Using the Wraparound team process, Care Coordination assists families who are not open in DCF in accessing and coordinating services for their child with significant behavioral health issues.

Family Based Recovery

Provides intensive in-home services for families with children birth to 36 months who have been exposed to parental substance abuse.

Provides intensive in-home, family focused and child specific interventions and case management to relative caregivers and secondarily, core foster families to promote family stability and children's permanency. Families are referred by DCF.

OUTPATIENT BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES

Counseling and Psychotherapy

Provides a wide range of services (individual, couple, family and group therapy) to help clients with issues such as: grief, depression, anxiety, trauma, life crisis, parenting, divorce and separation, substance abuse, physical and sexual abuse and emotional and behavioral problems of children, adolescents and adults. In conjunction with therapy services we also offer psychiatric evaluation and medication management.

UCFS offers the following treatment modalities that recognize individual and family value goals, accommodate variation in cultural life styles and emphasize personal growth, development and situational change: Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, Dialectical Behavioral Therapy, Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR), MATCH-ADTC, Motivational Interviewing, Seeking Safety, Social Learning, Solution Focused Therapy, Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy and Trauma Recovery Empowerment Model.

The Bettor Choice

Provides outpatient counseling (individual, couples, family and group) for adults (18+) who struggle with gambling as well as those affected by gambling (i.e., spouse, family members and significant others). Peer counseling services are also available.

Medication Assisted Treatment

Combines behavioral therapy and medications to treat substance use disorders. MAT services include the use of the medication Suboxone primarily, trained clinicians facilitating MAT groups using Evidence Based Practices, prescribers trained in addiction medicine, on-site laboratory collection and a recovery coach to assist clients in the recovery process.
