COMMUNITY OUTREACH SERVICES

Community Health Workers

Screens clients to determine their eligibility for insurance programs such as HUSKY/Medicaid, Access Health CT and more. Clients who are eligible are assisted in the application process. Community Health Workers also support the coordination of services for clients struggling with basic needs such as housing, food, employment and training or barriers accessing health care services.

OUTPATIENT BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES

Counseling and Psychotherapy

Provides a wide range of services (individual, couple, family and group therapy) to help clients with issues such as: grief, depression, anxiety, trauma, life crisis, parenting, divorce and separation, substance use, physical and sexual abuse and emotional and behavioral problems of children, adolescents and adults. In conjunction with therapy services we also offer psychiatric evaluation and medication management.

Autism

Offers a range of outpatient health, educational and behavioral services in one location for individuals with Autism and other developmental concerns including comprehensive assessments, psychopharmacology (medication), cognitive and behavioral interventions, social skills and communication, social learning groups, multi-family and parent groups.

Early Childhood ARC Program (ECAP)

ECAP specializes in cases involving children 0-6 and their families that have experienced a stressful or traumatic event and are now having behavior or impairment to their daily functioning. Using the Attachment, Regulation, and Competency (ARC) Framework, the caregiver-child duo will work with a clinician to strengthen their bond and attunement with each other.

Bettor Choice Gambling Treatment Program

Provides outpatient counseling (individual, couples, family and group) for adults (18+) who struggle with gambling as well as those affected by gambling (i.e., spouse, family members and significant others). Peer counseling and medication management services are also available.

Combines behavioral therapy and medications to treat substance use disorders. MAT services include the use of medication, trained clinicians, prescribers trained in addiction medicine, on-site laboratory collection and a recovery coach to assist clients in the recovery process.
